

TASMANIA – Dr Zuleika DEVEREAUX-McLEAN

Dr Zeik Devereaux-McLean is a Senior Resident Medical Officer at the Royal Hobart Hospital (RHH) and has demonstrated commitment to education and training by providing invaluable support to the Hospital, the University of Tasmania's medical education program, and the Postgraduate Medical Education Council of Tasmania.

Zeik willingly steps up to provide on-the-job education and guidance to interns and JMOs; in early 2021 she was the only Resident Medical Officer in the general medicine ward and was the first point of call for newly commenced interns.

At the end of her intern year, Zeik was integral to the RHH orientation of commencing interns through a 'Survival Skills' Q&A and smaller round-table sessions. As a PGY2 JMO, Zeik participated in intern teaching on common ward calls and dealing with medical emergencies, and provided guidance on 'what to do before the ICU registrar arrives'. She delivered a lecture on Myocarditis to the ICU JMOs in 2021.

Zeik is currently co-leading a clinical audit in trauma care and is an associate investigator in an active clinical trial in emergency airway techniques.
