WESTERN AUSTRALIA – Dr Fiona SPENCER

Dr Spencer is a Resident Medical Officer in the Western Australian Country Health Service and made an outstanding performance as an intern and as a RMO, winning Resident Medical Officer of the Year at the Bunbury Hospital in 2021.

Fiona led the creation of the Bunbury Doctors in Training Society and as President, initiated and sustained monthly education nights with two invited speakers from different disciplines each evening.

As a JMO representative, Fiona collaborated with Medical Education Officers and the Director of Clinical Training about the teaching structure and content for the protected teaching time. She has worked with the Rural Clinical School medical students to provide clinical exam practice sessions.

Fiona is a member of the Bunbury Doctor to Doctor Support mentor program committee and supports plans to build and sustain it as a long-term mentor program at the Hospital. She also supported the initiative of the Wellbeing and De-briefing Group for Doctors in Training to aid JMOs and teach reflective practice and soft skills.
